Antique Tractor Pull - Sunday June 18 1:00 p.m. PPMA TRACTOR PULL RULES OPERATION OF TRACTOR AND GENERAL RULES ALL CLASSES

1. SAFETY

2. \$8 Hitch fee in each class

3. Drivers must be 14 years or older (14 thru 17 must have written consent of parent or guardian.)

4. All weights stationary, secure and within confines of tractor not to extend beyond the rear tires. Front weight may only extend 2 ft. from original structure of tractor.

- 5. Each driver must supply his own twisted clevis with a 3 inch diameter opening and 7/8 inh minimum thickness.
- 6. Hitch must be stationary in all directions.
- 7. Hitch must be clear for hookup. (No weights hanging above hitch.)
- 8. Tractors can pull in only one category (Farmstock, Antique, or Open)
- 9. Tractors must be operated in a safe manner.
- 10. No riders. while pulling
- 11. Driver must remain seated at all times.
- 12. Driver must have tractor in neutral when hooking to and from sled, with both hands raised in the air.
- 13. Driver must slowly tighten chain and when given ok, with no jerking, pull at least 35 feet or two tries to move sled.
- 14. NO waiting on pull track for next pull.
- 15. No one on pull track except officials and puller.
- 16. If any part of tractor goes out of bounds, it will be disqualified.
- 17. If any parts fall off tractor, it will be disqualified.
- 18. Tractor may be disqualified if front end rises to an unsafe height.
- 19. Once tractor is weighed & approved, it must be taken to staging area not back to pits.
- 20. All pulls will be at the pullers risk.
- 21. Officials decisions are final. NO appeals will be heard or considered.
- 22. Tractors may pull two weight classes with same driver.
- 23. We have all stock equipment in place, its acceptable to replace generator with alternator or use electronic ignition.
- 24. No modified tires Shaved, Cut, Radial, or Duals
- 25. No tire chains
- 26. Drawbar length minimum of 18 inches from center of axle
- 27. Fuels allowed, automotive pump gasoline, diesel fuel, kerosene, and LP gas.
- 28. Operator & one helper admitted to pits without charge. Add'l pit passes, \$20 ea.

ADDITIONAL RULES FARMSTOCK

- 1. Factory hitch without modifications2. Factory working air cleaner.
- 3. Tire size must be within one size of original
- 4. Must pull in low gear with no shifting of torque, ground speed under 3 MPH
- 5. RPM must be within 10% of original specifications
- 6. Maximum hitch height of 20 inches7. Rim size must be original

ADDITIONAL RULES ANTIQUE

- 1. Hitch height maximum of 20 inches. 18 inches from center of axle minimum length
- 2. Wheelie bars allowed

ADDITIONAL RULES OPEN

- 1. No tractors equipped with aouomotive or truck engines.
- 2. No alcohol or methanol fuels, turbo blue or cam 2 ok.
- 3. Hitch height maximum of 20 inches. 18 inches from the center of axle minimum length.
- 4. Ground speed should be no faster than 2nd gear or 5.5 mph.
- 5. Can pull in 1st or 2nd and allowed one shift or a torque amplifier or power shift. (NO CLUTCH SHIFT)
- 6. Wheelie bars allowed.
