Judged on uniformity of color, bees, presence of queen, brood and honey, cleanliness & appearance of hive.

Comb honey to be judged in perfection in filling, uniformity in capping, neatness & cleanliness of section.

Extracted honey to be judged on body, clarity and cleanliness.

Beeswax is to be judged on color and purity.

2. Honey, light comb, one section
3. Honey, dark comb, one section
4. Light extracted honey, one pound jar
5. Dark extracted honey, one pound jar

9. Collective exhibit of honey, wax, honey products

Section 2 - Maple Products

Syrup is to be judged on flavor, density and clarity. Sugar is to be judged on flavor, appearance and texture.

- CLASS 1. Maple Syrup, one quart container
2. Maple Sugar, one pound cake
 3. Maple Cream, one pound cake
 4. Maple sugar, soft, small individual cakes not less than one pound
 5. Collective exhibit of maple products
